

# Book Page Wreath

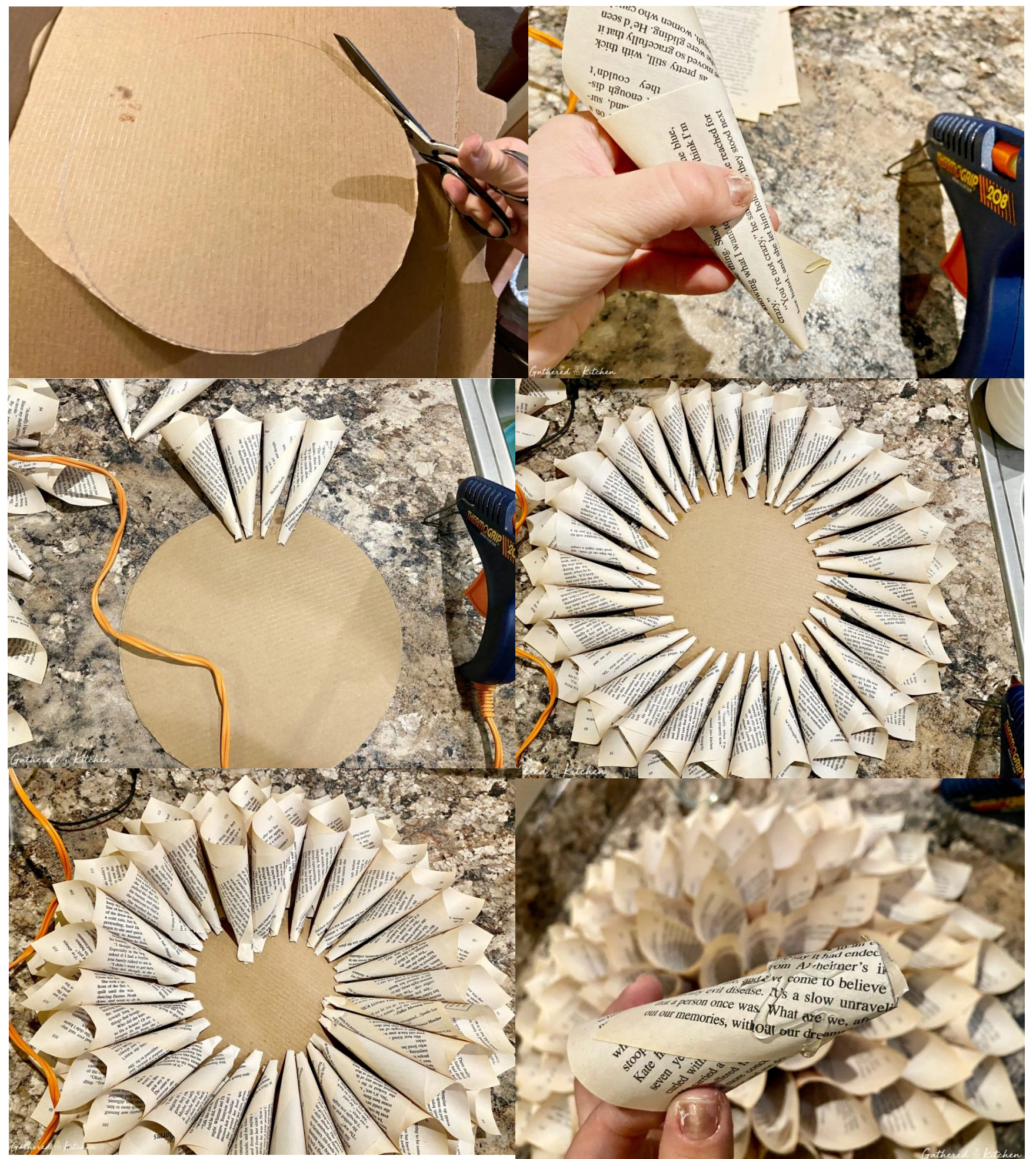


## Materials

- Old book pages - 125 sheets included
- Cardboard template (circle)
- Scissors (NOT included)
- Hot glue or clear tape (NOT Included)

## Instructions

1. Start by cutting out the circle template.
2. Next, roll each book page on a diagonal and hot glue or tape the bottom corner to the roll.
3. Place a dab of hot glue/piece of tape on the bottom of each roll and place about 1" from the bottom of the roll on the cardboard.
4. Continue around the entire circle. Be sure to space your rolls so they touch at the widest part, not the narrowest. Row 2 should be placed slightly below the 1st row. Row 3 will require the rolls to be slightly bent up at the bottom of the roll and so on.
5. The very last roll is the center circle piece. You will have to cut it down on the tops just a bit to make it not so tall and "higher on one side". Place hot glue or tape around the entire roll and place it in the middle.
6. Hang it up and enjoy!
