Book Page Wreath



Materials

- Old book pages 125 sheets included
- Cardboard template (circle)
- Scissors (NOT included)
- Hot glue or clear tape (NOT Included)

Instructions

- 1. Start by cutting out the circle template.
- 2. Next, roll each book page on a diagonal and hot glue or tape the bottom corner to the roll.
- 3. Place a dab of hot glue/piece of tape on the bottom of each roll and place about 1" from the bottom of the roll on the cardboard.
- 4. Continue around the entire circle. Be



sure to space your rolls so they touch at the widest part, not the narrowest. Row 2 should be placed slightly below the 1st row. Row 3 will require the rolls to be slightly bent up at the bottom of the roll and so on.

- 5. The very last roll is the center circle piece. You will have to cut it down on the tops just a bit to make it not so tall and "higher on one side". Place hot glue or tape around the entire roll and place it in the middle.
- 6. Hang it up and enjoy!
