



# Materials List

- 1. glass vase
- 2. hot glue
- 3. 40 corks

# Instructions: Step 1



Gather supplies and lay out the corks to see them aligned with the glass vase. It works best to start with 2 corks lying flat stacked to make four rows. Repeat this pattern on the opposite side. For the pattern the other two sides, line 4 corks standing up to make two rows. Once you are satisfied with your layout, move to step two to start gluing things in place. Note: you will have to move the corks to start gluing.

#### Step 3

Once all corks are glued onto glass vase, use the remaining corks on each corner.
Glue in place each cork so they are a stack of two. See photo below.



## Step 2



To glue, put a line of hot glue along the back of the cork. Hold the cork in place for about 10 seconds until it sticks. Repeat the same step for the next cork adding glue to the side of the cork so it sticks to the one that you just glued on previously. It is best to work on one cork at a time then move on to the next one.

## Step 4

Once all corks are glued onto glass vase, let dry for 24 hours. Place beautiful plants in the cork planter and enjoy!
