

DIY *Ribbon* Bookmark



Materials (supplies to make 1 bookamrk in kit)

- Decorative Ribbon at least 1/2 in. wide
- Elastic Hair Band
- Decorative Button
- Scissors
- Needle & Thread and/or Sewing machine

Instructions:

1. Using an 18' piece of ribbon, fold one end of the ribbon over 1/4 inch. Fold it over another 1/4 inch and stitch across. You can do this by hand, or use a sewing machine.
2. Repeat step for the other end of ribbon, adding the elastic hair band before you start folding to attach it to the ribbon.
3. Now we have one end of the ribbon bookmark done. Half way there!
4. Use your needle and thread to attach a button to the other end of the ribbon. We're all done!
5. To use, just wrap your ribbon bookmark around your book and pull the elastic up and around the button to secure it into place.
