



## Materials

- 6 clothespins 3 for each carrot stack
- orange paint
- hot glue
- green raffia
- twine
- buffalo check ribbon (white & black)
- paintbrush

## Instructions:

- 1. You will need 6 clothespins to make two sets of carrots. Start by breaking them in half and remove the metal pieces.
- 2. Paint pieces with orange acrylic paint. Let dry.
- 3. While the pieces are drying, cut the green raffia into six pieces. Gently, open and stretch the paper material and cut strips. This will be the top of each carrot.
  4. After drying, hot glue green raffia to the backside of one wood piece for each carrot.



- 5. Next, glue wood pieces together back to back.
- 6. Wrap twine around the top of carrot.
- 7. Layer carrots in stack as shown in photo and glue.
- 8. Add a buffalo check bow.
