

Tissue Paper Vase



Materials List

- Vase or glass jar
- mod podge
- sponge brush
- tissue paper cut or torn into any shape. If you have a craft punch on hand, that would also work.

Instructions:

1. Prepare your tissue paper. You can tear or cut it into small pieces. If you have a craft punch on hand, that will also work.
2. Apply a light coat of mod podge to a small section of the vase. Mod podge dries quickly, so it's best to work in small areas of the vase as you go.
3. Begin applying tissue paper to it in a collage like pattern. Cover the entire vase in tissue paper, making sure to press the tissue paper down for a smooth finish.
4. Once covered, let the vase dry.
5. After the tissue paper has dried, add a final layer of mod podge on top to seal the vase and water-proof it. Please note: it is not dishwasher safe even though there is a later for waterproofing.
