

## **Materials List**


- Patterned Paper
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Tacky Glue
- Hot Glue
- Wreath or Hoop

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Start by making simple paper pinwheels. Use a pencil to draw a straight line from each corner to the opposite corner, creating a large X shape across the square paper. Use scissors to cut from each corner into the middle, stopping half an inch before the center—be careful not to cut any of the pieces off.
- 2. Once you've made all four cuts on the square paper, use tacky glue to turn the paper into pinwheels. Place a drop of glue in the center of the X shape and fold down one corner so the point comes to the center of the paper. Hold down the corner until the glue dries, then add another drop of glue and fold in the next corner. Repeat this step for each corner until the pinwheel is finished.
- 3. Finally, add pinwheels to wreath with a dab of hot glue on the back.
