

Scarecrow Mason Jar



Materials List

- mason jar
- tan, brown, black & orange paint
- faux hay
- burlap ribbon
- large googly eyes
- fake sunflower
- black permanent marker
- paint brushes
- hot glue
- scissors

Instructions:

1. Lay down a piece of newspaper or scrap paper before you get started. Paint the outside of your Mason the dark brown paint using the largest brush. Let dry.
2. After the jar is dry, use the smaller paint brush to paint on a triangle shaped nose on the front center of your Mason jar with the orange paint.
3. Use a black sharpie marker draw a wavy smile under the nose with several dashes through the smile, as well as around the nose.
4. Next, paint on two small circles for the cheeks at each side of the smile using the lightest brown paint.
5. Carefully glue two googly eyes above the nose with your hot glue gun.
6. Using the faux hay, cut two sets of 10 strands of straw about 3-4" in length and tie the strands together with another piece of straw for the hair. Carefully glue to each top side of the Mason jar.
7. Glue the burlap ribbon around the top of the Mason Jar.
8. Glue a sunflower onto the top left side of the burlap and your scarecrow is complete!
