



Materials List

- Clothespins
- Glitter Glue
- Tacky Glue
- Ribbon (optional)

Instructions:

- 1. Take clothespins apart and get rid of the springs. You need 8 to 10 clothespins per snowflake, depending on how want it to look.
- 2. Apply just a very, very thin line of tacky glue to the clothespins.
- 3. Press the clothespin together firmly and wipe away any glue that seeps out.
- 4. Depending on the pattern of your fancy snowflake, you'll need to glue your clothespins in the 2 ways shown in the phone marked pattern below.
- 5. There are three designs in these instructions. Two can be done with 8 clothespins and the third can be made with 10.
- 6. Use minimal glue and clean up any that oozes out when putting your snowflakes together. Once pieced lay them on a flat surface and allow the glue plenty of time to dry. Overnight is best. Once fully dry test the joins and reattach any arms of the snowflake that are loose.
- 7. Add glitter glue to your snowflake for a sparkle and a ribbon if you wish!


