

# DIY clothespin Snowflakes

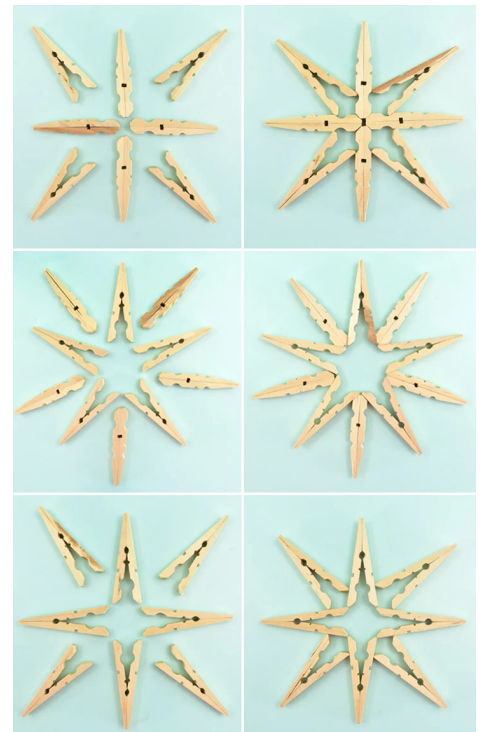
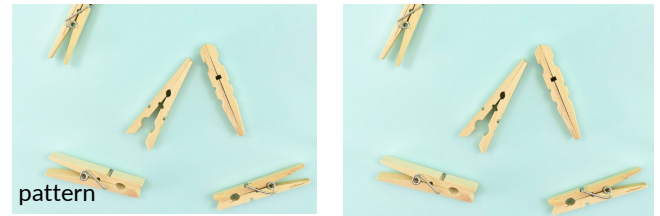


## Materials List

- Clothespins
- Glitter Glue
- Tacky Glue
- Ribbon (optional)

## Instructions:

1. Take clothespins apart and get rid of the springs. You need 8 to 10 clothespins per snowflake, depending on how you want it to look.
2. Apply just a very, very thin line of tacky glue to the clothespins.
3. Press the clothespin together firmly and wipe away any glue that seeps out.
4. Depending on the pattern of your fancy snowflake, you'll need to glue your clothespins in the 2 ways shown in the phone marked pattern below.
5. There are three designs in these instructions. Two can be done with 8 clothespins and the third can be made with 10.
6. Use minimal glue and clean up any that oozes out when putting your snowflakes together. Once pieced lay them on a flat surface and allow the glue plenty of time to dry. Overnight is best. Once fully dry test the joins and reattach any arms of the snowflake that are loose.
7. Add glitter glue to your snowflake for a sparkle and a ribbon if you wish!
