

# French Flower Pot



## Materials

- Terra-cotta pot
- White acrylic paint
- Brush
- Mod Podge
- Foam brush for Mod Podge
- Scissors
- Oval French label printed on cardstock

## Instructions:

1. Using the white paint, dry brush the pot to "age" it. Dip the tip of your brush into the paint and dab away the excess until almost all the paint from the brush has been removed. Use a disposable plate, paper or cloth for dabbing the paint BEFORE brushing it on the pot.
2. next, paint long irregular brush strokes all around the pot, applying not too much pressure.
3. Brush a little bit of paint on the inside of the pot to create a more cohesive final whitewash look.
4. Cut out a label and adhere it to the pot using mod podge.
5. Dry brush white paint over the label to give an imperfect look.
6. Use the remaining mod podge to seal the label.
