

Wine Cork Bats

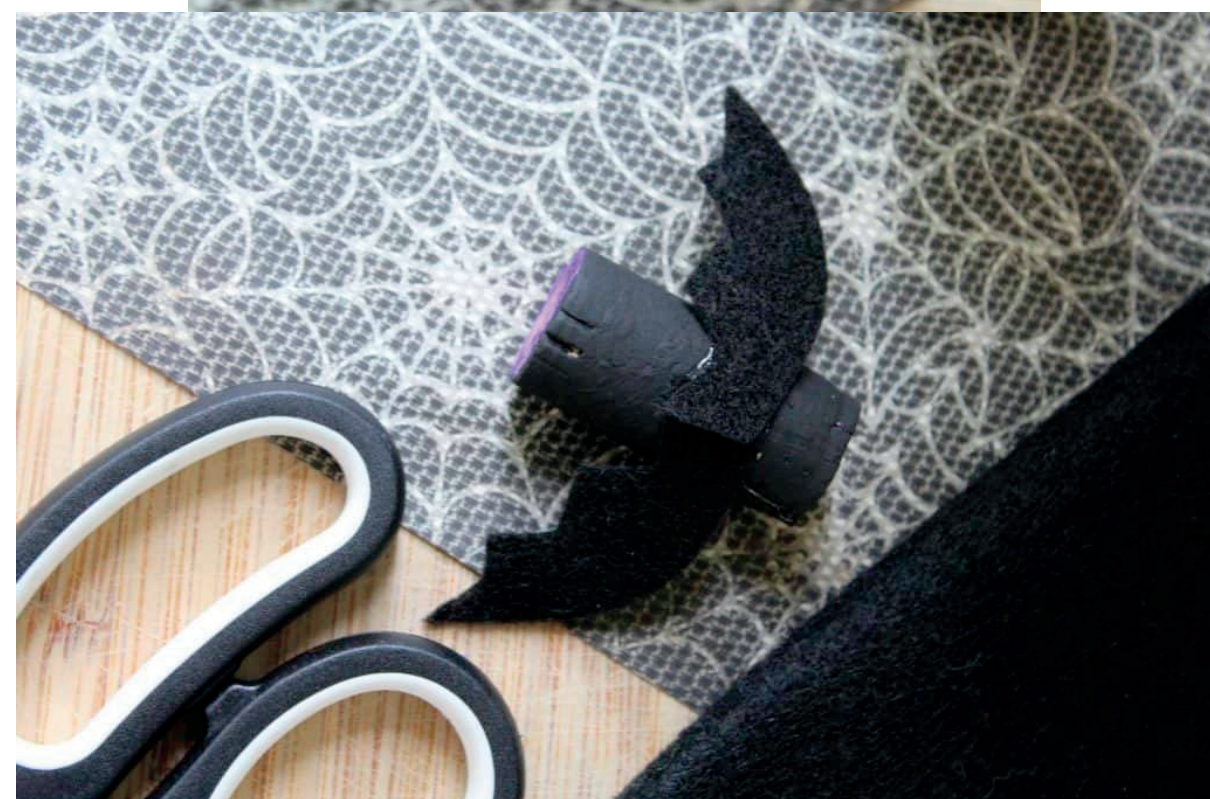


Materials

- Wine cork
- Black craft paint
- Pair of googly eyes
- White and black craft felt
- Scissors
- Hot glue, glue gun
- Paint brush
- Magnet

Instructions:

1. Begin by applying two coats of paint to the wine cork. Two coats will provide even and thorough coverage. Let the cork dry thoroughly.
2. While the cork dries, you can create the face of the bat. Two white triangles are perfect for fangs.
3. Create the wings by cutting two jagged ovals out from the black felt. You can freehand these and shape them to your liking.
4. Once the paint is dry, glue the wings and fangs on as shown.
5. Finish the wine cork bats by adding a pair of googly eyes and a magnet to the back.
