

# Wood Block Pumpkin

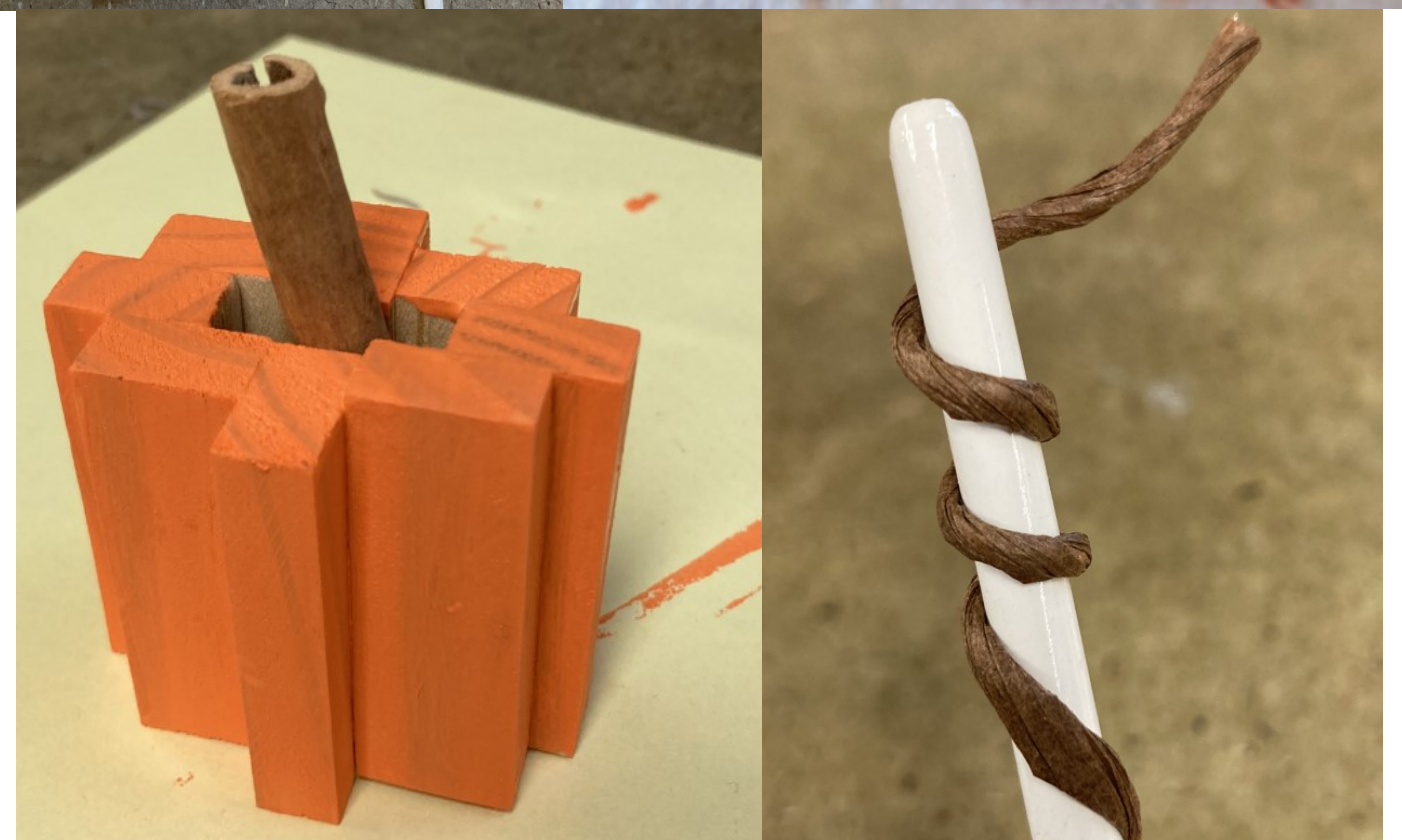


## Materials

- 8 wood pieces (Jenga Blocks from Dollar Tree)
- 2 ounces of orange paint
- 1 paint brush
- 1 piece of brown wire twine
- spanish moss
- wood stick
- hot glue
- scissors
- pencil

## Instructions:

1. Paint all sides of the blocks orange and let dry.
2. Next, hot glue them together 3 on each side.
3. Cut the stick down to size and place it inside the open space.
4. Using your pencil, wrap the brown wire twine around it to create a stem. You may need to trim it to fit with your scissors. Attach it to the stick with either a dab of hot glue or wrap it on the end of the stick.
5. Add the spanish moss.
