What's Summer at the Library all about?

Summer Library Battle of the Books

How does it work?

For full list of rules, please obtain a copy of the B.O.B. Guidelines from a Youth Librarian. You'll be participating as a team for Hartford against other Monarch Library System teens. You'll be guizzed on the B.O.B. competition books. For example, a question may state, "Which book has a character that finds out he is the son of Poseidon?" The team would answer, "The Lightning Thief by Rick Riordan." Questions about all of the books will be asked and will range in difficulty. Teams gain points for every answer they have right. In the end, whichever team has the most points wins!

Before beginning the program, all participants and their parents must sign a permission slip and return it to the Youth Services Librarian. This will ensure that both participants and their parents have received a copy of how the program works, what the rules are, and what books are on the list!
