

Yarn Pumpkin Garland



Materials List

- Orange Yarn
- Green Pipe Cleaners
- Twine
- Scissors
- Clothespins**

Instructions:

1. Wrap yarn around four fingers (or a piece of cardboard as wide as your four fingers!) about 120 times or so.
2. Wrap a piece of yarn around the middle. Cut a ~10 inch piece of yarn and stick it between your fingers to wrap it around the big yarn loop.
3. Tie the yarn tightly. Line up the piece of yarn in the middle of the yarn loop, and tie – pulling taut and wrapping around the backside as well.
4. Add pipe cleaner stem. You now have your basic pumpkin shape. Cut a 2 inch piece of pipe cleaner and tie to the pumpkin using the two loose strands of yarn from Step 3. Don't trim the strands yet! Wrap the pipe cleaner around itself to form the stem.
5. Form pumpkin shape. Pretty up your pumpkin by tucking in any loose loops.
6. Tie pumpkins to twine. Once again using the loose strings on the pumpkin to tie them around the twine. Space out each pumpkin 6 inches or so along the twine. Continue making pumpkins until you have enough for your yarn pumpkin garland! ***You can also use clothes pins to attach pumpkins to twine to make garland.*
